

NOTCHED BORDER

A notched border may be a “scallop” with a ‘V” in it or notches with sharper corners.

For a more *rounded edge*, you may want to use a recipe (3 x 5) card and draw in a “V” shape that is not more than a 90 degree “V” and about 1” deep or less.

Choose where you want your “notches” and mark using your favorite method.

If you use a more rounded edge of your “V”, a bias binding will work much better.



For a notched border with *sharper corners* use a small square ruler and mark, using your favorite method of marking.

Make your notches 1” deep or less.

This notched border may use binding cut on the WOF. A single fold binding does work much better.

This notched border does take time to put the border on as you are stopping and starting frequently.

When sewing on the binding, stop with the needle down at the "V", straighten the "V", take a stitch or two, and sew on.
